Tube/Underground stations

- **Holborn** (Piccadilly and Central lines) - on the corner of Kingsway and High Holborn. Approximately five minutes away from the venue and hotel.
- **Temple** (District and Circle lines) - on the Embankment at the bottom of Arundel Street. Approximately five minutes away from the venue and hotel.

- **Charing Cross** (Jubilee, Northern and Bakerloo lines) - on the Strand at the Trafalgar Square end. Approximately ten minutes away from the venue and hotel.

National rail stations

- **Waterloo** - other side of the River from the Strand over Waterloo Bridge. Approximately 10-15 minutes away. Trains to and from the south coast and south west of England.
- **Charing Cross** - on the Strand at the Trafalgar Square end. Approximately 10 minutes away. Trains mainly to south east London and into Kent.
- **Blackfriars** - on the Embankment near Blackfriars Bridge. Approximately 10 -15 minutes away. Trains mainly to south London and south east England but also the Thameslink line through north London.
- **St Pancras International** - on Euston Road, close to King's Cross mainline station. Take the Piccadilly Line from King's Cross to Holborn, from where it is a 5 minutes away (see 'Holborn' above). Serves the Eurostar and trains to the Midlands.
