



CEPR/JIE School on Applied Industrial Organisation

Madrid, 13-15 June 2019

The CEPR/JIE Applied IO School will be organised in Madrid as part of the CEPR Conference on Applied Industrial Organisation, 13-15 June 2019.

The goal of the school is to provide a forum for young European researchers in Applied IO to get exposure for and receive feedback on their work. In the second year of an experiment assessing how best to fulfil these goals, the school will take place in an “augmented” poster-session format in 2019.

School Details:

Researchers accepted to the school will give very short (<10 min) presentations of their work at some point during the conference and participate in poster sessions during extended lunch periods on both full days of the conference. Conference attendees will be informed of the goals of the school, attend the school participant presentations, and encouraged to engage with the poster-session presenters. School participants will be invited to attend the Applied IO Conference (13-15 June 2019) as part of the school. Eligibility:

Given its goals, only young researchers pursuing or having recently (within four years) received a PhD from a European economics program are eligible. Preference will be given to those students expecting to go on the academic job market in 2019-20, with additional (though lesser) preference given to other applicants according to their time since PhD completion.

If you are or know of a pre- or post-doctoral researcher that may want to attend the school, please pass this invitation on to them. To attend, the individual must have a completed paper that they will present in the main conference and a poster to present in the poster session. Posters should be no larger than that associated with A0-sized paper (841 x 1,189 mm).

School Submissions and Deadlines:

The deadline for submissions is **Friday 18 January, 2019 at 18:00 (GMT)** and must include a research paper, a CV, and (for pre-doctoral researchers only) a short letter of support from their main advisor

(max 1 page). Letters of support can optionally be sent separately to mchan@cepr.org. Authors will be notified about whether their paper has been accepted in March 2019.
