Travel

Transfers

The transfer bus will leave the Bank in Rome (via Nazionale, 91) around 15:30/16:00 and going to Fiumicino airport. From Fiumicino, we plan to leave for Perugia around 17:00.

Participants who arrive the day before or on Thursday morning may come to the Bank (which is located in the centre of Rome), leave their luggage at the Bank's porter's, take a stroll in the city centre and than be ready for the pick-up at 15:30/16:00.

Participants arriving at Fiumicino airport on Thursday afternoon will be collected at Terminal 3 – Arrivals Floor – in front of the bookshop to the left side of the hall once you walk out of the luggage area. From Fiumicino, we plan to leave for Perugia around 17:00.

By Car:

From FIRENZE (Bologna - Roma):

Motorway A1 exit Val di Chiana.

After Valdichiana take the junction (**raccordo**) **Bettolle-Perugia** and exit in **PREPO**. Turn right then follow the signs indicating Banca d'Italia-S.A.Di.Ba.

From ROMA (via Orte-Todi -SS. E45) (**suggested track**)

Follow **SS. E45**, about 900 meters after the exit Balanzano take the junction **Perugia-Firenze** then take junction (**raccordo**) **Perugia-Bettolle (SS. n. 75-bis)**.

Once arrived in Perugia, take the **second exit: PREPO**. Turn right then follow the signs indicating Banca d'Italia.-S.A.Di.Ba.

How to Reach Sadiba from Perugia Stations

City transportation A.P.M.

- Line B: from Fontivegge (station) to S. Marco Fornaci (nearby SADIBA) every 40 minutes during working days and every hour during holidays.
- Line 106: from Fontivegge (station) to S. Marco Fornaci from 6:25am to 2.03pm.
- Line E: from Piazza Partigiani (bus-terminal) to S. Marco Fornaci (nearby SADIBA) around every 50 minutes.

- Line E: from S. Marco Fornaci (nearby SADIBA) to Piazza Partigiani (bus-terminal) then take the sliding scale every 50 minutes until 9:05pm.
- Line K: from S. Marco Fornaci (nearby SADIBA) to Piazza Cavallotti (city centre) every hour and until 7:59pm.
