Authors should also send final drafts of their paper to Nadine Clarke by **Monday 7 June** at the latest; otherwise they cannot be copied in time for the meeting.

Accommodation

Rooms have been reserved for the participants at the following hotels in Rome:

Hotel Mediterraneo - via Cavour 15

Hotel Massimo d'Azeglio - Via Cavour 18

Hotel Nord Nuova Roma - Via Giovanni Amendola 3

Confirmed participants will receive an email with details of their accommodation.

Single rooms are charged at **EUR 210** per night (EUR 195 at Nord Nuova Roma). Breakfast and taxes are included in the price.

Car parking space is available at the hotel (**EUR 35** a day approximately; please book in advance).

For participants whose accommodation costs are covered by the organizers, please be reminded that incidental expenses such as the mini-bar, laundry, telephone, Internet or any other service offered by the hotel are **not** covered and should be settled with the hotel directly.

Transport

The nearest airports to Rome are **Rome Fiumicino** (or Leonardo da Vinci), 26 km southwest of Rome, and **Rome Ciampino**, 16 km southeast of Rome.

Fiumicino to the city centre

From **Fiumicino**, there are direct trains into Rome **Termini** station (platform 22). The journey is approximately 35 minutes (running every 07 and 37 minutes past the hour, with the first train at 06h37 and the last at 23h37) and costs EUR 14. Trains to Roma **Ostiense** (final destination Fara Sabina) depart every 12, 27, 42, 57 minutes past the hour (30 minutes journey; Sundays: 27, 57 only); from Ostiense a subway run to Termini is 10 minutes (fare EUR8+EUR1 for the metro). Tickets at newspaper boot or rail counter.

Alternatively, participants can take a taxi from Fiumicino to the centre. The journey will cost EUR 40 (fixed fare, one piece of luggage per person included) and take around 40 minutes.

Ciampino to the city centre

From **Ciampino**, buses can be taken to Metro station **Anagnina** on **metro line A**, from where the metro takes you to **Termini** station in 30 minutes. The bus to **Anagnina** station runs every 40 minutes and costs EUR 1.20 (tickets can be bought from the driver). The bus journey can take up to 20 minutes, depending on traffic.

There is also a Terravision bus service from Ciampino to Termini station directly, which takes around 40 minutes. Tickets can be booked on line for EUR 4 each way: http://www.terravision.eu/rome_ciampino.html

Alternatively, participants can take a taxi from Ciampino to the centre. The journey will cost EUR 30 (fixed fare, one piece of luggage per person included) and take around 30 minutes.

Meals

Breakfast should be taken at the hotel.

Lunch and refreshments will be provided for at the conference venues throughout the days of the conference.

Dinner arrangements will be communicated to the participants during the conference.

Dietary requirements can be accommodated if and as indicated in advance.
