## Travel

### **From the Airport**

Paris-Charles de Gaulle Airport is the most convenient airport.

Taxis from the airport to hotel venue could cost up to 100€, please be aware taxi cost will not be covered by expenses.

#### From airports/stations to the conference venue:

- **From Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport:** take RER (rapid transit system) B southbound to *Cité Universitaire* (via Paris). Journey time is 60 min.
- **From Orly airport :** Orlybus bound to Paris, stop at *Tombe Issoire* (the first stop in Paris). Journey time is 45 min.
- **From Gare du Nord:** take RER B southbound to *Cité Universitaire* (fastest) or line 4 to *Porte d'Orléans* (slower). Journey time 30 min.

#### From airports/stations to the conference hotels:

##### - To Ibis Paris Cambronne Tour Eiffel

- From Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport: **take RER B southbound to Denfert-Rochereau** (via Paris) and take line 6 from **Denfert-Rochereau to Cambronne**. Journey time is 60 min.
- **From Orly airport:** Orlybus bound to Paris, stop at **Denfert-Rochereau** and take line 6 from **Denfert-Rochereau to Cambronne**. Journey time is 40 min.
- **From Gare du Nord:** take Line 4 southbound to **Strasbourg-Saint-Denis** and the line 8 from **Strasbourg-Saint-Denis to La Motte-Picquet Grenelle**. Journey time is 30 min.

##### - To Hotel Terminus Orléans Paris

- From Roissy Charles de Gaulle airport: **take RER B southbound to Denfert-Rochereau** (via Paris) then take line 4 from **Denfert-Rochereau to Porte d'Orleans (General Leclerc)**. Journey time is 60 min.
- **From Orly airport:** Orlybus bound to Paris, stop at **Montsouris-Tombe Issoire** and walk 7 min. Journey time is 25 min.
- **From Gare du Nord:** take Line 4 southbound to **Porte d'Orleans (General Leclerc)**. Journey time is 30 min.

#### From the conference hotels to the conference venue:

- **Hotel IBIS to Campus Jourdan:** Metro line 6 from *Cambronne* to *Raspail* and Line 4 from *Raspail* to *Porte d'Orléans*, then walk. Journey time is 25 min.
- **Hotel Hotel Terminus Orléans Paris to Campus Jourdan:** walking distance. Journey time is 10 min.
